

This experience includes activities such as: handling, tracking depositing monies; using software programs to maintain financial/accounting data (such as fee and stock data); performing fi collection, accounting of financial duties; or using tools or equipment (e.g., cash registers, calculators, etc.) to make sales trar ensuring accountability of funds and accurate financial records.
