- Badwater Talk:** Visit an extreme part of the park and learn about the unique forces that create the lowest, hottest and driest place in North America.
- Harmony Borax Talk:** Learn about fascinating mining history in Death Valley. 20 mule team wagons, borax, fortunes and more! Easy 1/3 mile walk on a paved path.
- Golden Canyon Hike:** Hike with a ranger through one of Death Valley's most popular and beautiful canyons. Easy walk with one small scramble. Approximately 1 mile. Bring water, a hat and hiking shoes.
- Dunes Sunset Walk:** Join a ranger for an easy stroll at one of the best sunset viewing locations in Death Valley.
- Night Sky Talk:** Join a ranger to learn more about the incredible night sky in Death Valley! Optional items: red light to protect night vision, binoculars, chair.
- Evening Ranger Talk:** Join a ranger in the Furnace Creek Auditorium for an evening presentation. Check the visitor center for topics.
- Family Program:** Families with kids aged 4 to 12 meet a ranger in the Visitor Center courtyard to explore Death Valley's wildlife, plants, history and more! Junior Rangers welcome.
- Full Moon Walk:** Watch the moon rise and illuminate your way as you join a ranger on an easy night walk on the moonlit sand dunes.
